His testimony of forgiveness after his brother was murdered for his faith, was an explosive topic for transformation with the Jewish visitors that were invited. The common Christian in Belgium does not accept that God loves Israel. Many were challenged to accept God's word and plan for Israel.

This South American team demonstrated UNITY in the body of Christ as they joined with Hope for Wallonia to impact the Belgium. Hope for Wallonia is also a positive step toward unity as they coordinate efforts to reach the French-speaking parts of Belgium.
